 - Trillium Lodge site location confirmed-2011

Current Services in Oceanside

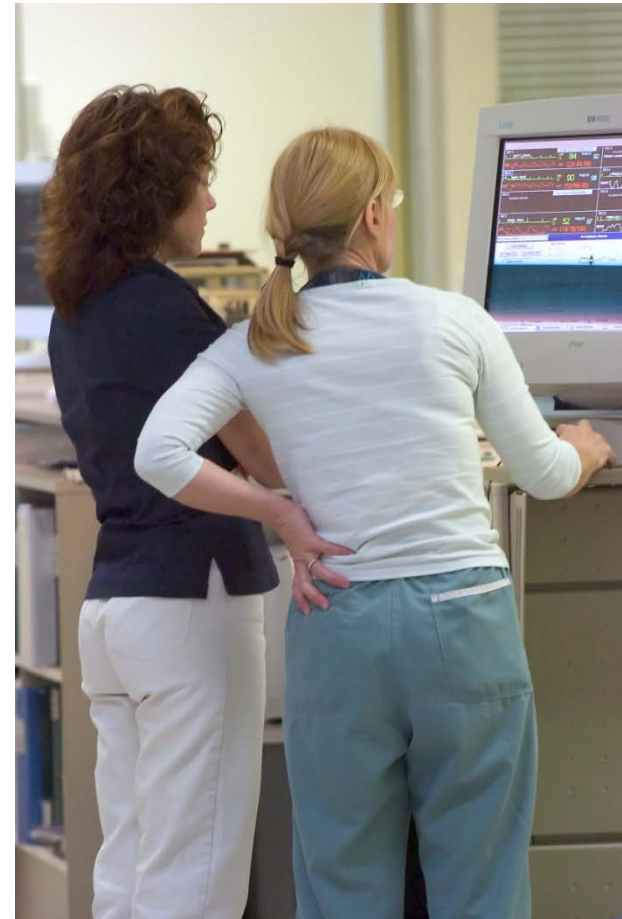
- ◆ Current community feedback

 - ▶ ER in Nanaimo
 - ▶ Support Services not integrated



Proposed Services

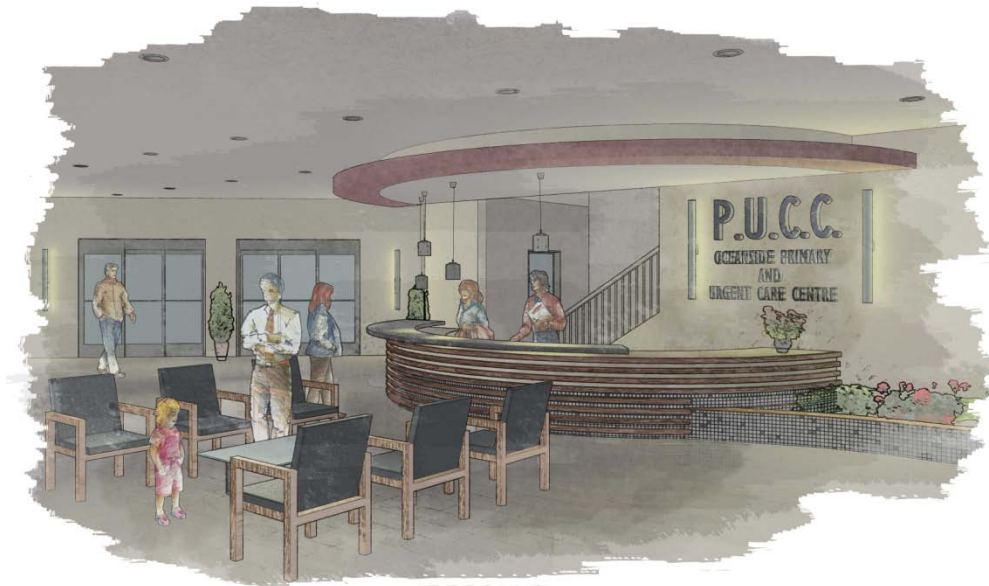
◆ Core Services

- ▶ Community Care
- ▶ Rehabilitation
- ▶ Mental Health and Addictions Services
- ▶ Co-located VIHA services



Project Goals

- ▶ Improved access to primary care for population of Oceanside
- ▶ More services closer to home
- ▶ Increased Service Hours for Primary Health Care & Urgent Care

- ▶ Evidence Based approach

- ▶ X-ray, Lab, Pharmacy



Future Patient Experience

- ◆ Patient Centred Approach
- ◆ Multidisciplinary teams – expanded support services
- ◆ Specialist Care Polyclinic
- ◆ Continuum of care
- ◆ Supported by shared electronic patient profile/ records

Proposed Project Timelines

- ◆ Preferred Proponent Chosen – June 30, 2010
- ◆ Zoning and Subdivision approval – March 2011
- ◆ Confirm Service Model – May 2011
- ◆ Commence Construction – July 2011
- ◆ Complete Construction – November 2012
- ◆ Open for Services to Patients – end 2012
