

Campbell River Hospital

Campbell River Hospital is a 59-bed acute care facility located on northern Vancouver Island in the city of Campbell River.

Emergency Services are provided 24/7 and include a Crisis Team (7 days/week) plus 2 female General Practitioners (sexual assault services).

Bed capacity:

- 10 stretcher bays, 8 monitors + 4 chairs (IV therapy, fast track)
- 2 bay cast room
- 1 large resuscitation room
- 1 ear/nose/throat - gynecology room
- 1 suture room/negative pressure room

In-Patient Services include: anaesthesia, orthopedics, general surgery (3 operating room theatres and endoscopy suite), plastics, ear, nose and throat (ENT), urology, dental, internal medicine, paediatrics, radiology, pathology, and obstetrics/ gynecology.

Outpatient Services include: physiotherapy, occupational therapy (including a hand program), diabetes education, nutrition services, the North Island Liver Services, medical day care and laboratory.

Diagnostic Imaging Services include Picture Archiving and Communication (PACS), ultrasound, CT scanner, bone density, mammography, echo-cardiography and fluoroscopy.

Clinics include a comprehensive Stroke Care Program, a Pacemaker Clinic, a Cancer Care Clinic, and a Wound Care Clinic with an enterostomy nurse.

Intensive Care Services (ICU)

The 5-bed unit includes a negative pressure room. Staffing team includes a respiratory therapist (Monday-Friday), 5 internists and a respirologist.

Medical/Surgical Services

There are 3 labor/delivery rooms, a medical daycare and palliative care unit. Staffing includes 5 internists, 2 pediatricians, 1 ear/nose/throat (ENT) specialist, 2 plastic surgeons; 3 general surgeons; 3 orthopedic surgeons (arthroscopic surgery, joint replacement & orthopedic trauma surgery); 1 obstetrics/gynecologist, anaesthetists, 1 dental surgeon and a visiting urologist.
