Capacity: 24 stretchers including a 4-bed trauma/resuscitation room; 9 monitors; 1 psychiatric room; 1 gynecology room; 1 EENT room; 1 negative pressure room; 5 bay Medical/Surgical Overflow; 3-bay Fast Track area; Ambulatory/Streaming area. A new ER is currently under construction, scheduled to open September 2012.

Separate psychiatric emergency service. Medical/surgical RN staffing for admitted patients holding in ER.
