The goal of clinical research in palliative and end-of-life care is to benefit persons with terminal illnesses and their families. We invite manuscripts that describe clinical research studies in the area of palliative and end-of-life care as well as those that address methodological issues and challenges in conducting clinical research. Clinical research is broadly defined in terms of individual patients, families and communities, care settings, diseases, and trajectories (including bereavement). It entails a diversity of methodological designs, such as qualitative, mixed method, and quantitative designs. This special issue of the Journal is intended to highlight the diversity and challenges of clinical research in the field of palliative and end-of-life care.
